POT B (next group by FIFA ranking): Canada (7), Netherlands (8), Brazil (9), Japan (11), Norway (12), Italy (14), China (15), South Korea (17)

POT C (next group by rank): Denmark (18), Switzerland (21), Ireland (24), Colombia (27), Argentina (29), Vietnam (34), Costa Rica (37), Jamaica (43)

POT D (remaining teams + 3 playoff teams to be determined in February): Nigeria (45), Philippines (53), South Africa (54), Morocco (76), Zambia (81)

THE DRAW PROCESS

Starting with Pot A, teams will be drawn one by one and placed into the eight groups of four teams each. Hosts New Zealand and Australia will automatically have the top spot in Group A and B, while the other teams from Pot A will occupy the #1 spot in Groups C to H. Positions of the other teams will be determined when they are drawn from their pots. With the exception of European teams, no teams from the same confederation can be drawn into the same group. No more than two European teams can be in the same group.

GROUPS OUTLINED IN BLUE will play all their group-stage games in New Zealand.

GROUPS OUTLINED IN NEON RED will play all their group-stage games in Australia.
